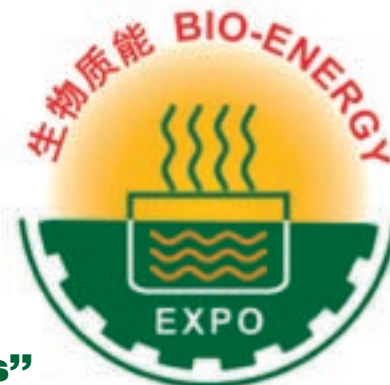

## The market for biogas in China

The People's Republic of China pushes ahead with expansion of its animal farming sector with currently 11,952 medium and large pig, cattle and poultry farms producing an annual 1,420 million tonnes manure. Based on this manure, the People's Republic of China is developing its biogas production. Currently 3,800 biogas plants produce 2,500 million m<sup>3</sup> biogas per year.

The largest plants have an electricity potential of 2 MW.

### Target for 2010:

4,700 medium and large biogas plants with an annual electricity production of 0.8 GW.

### Target for 2020:

10,000 biogas plants with an annual electricity production of 3.0 GW.

## CAHE

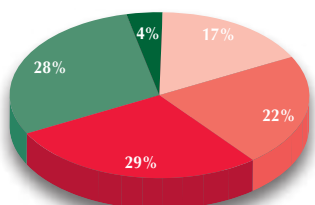
**Bio-Energy-Expo** is part of the China Animal Husbandry & Feed Industry Expo (CAHE), an exhibition staged since 1997. It is an annual event and covers the requirements of modern intensive farm animal production with regard to breeding, machinery/equipment, management, input materials and supporting service industries. In 2008 the exhibition covered 50,000 m<sup>2</sup> gross area.
